72-Hour Emergency Preparedness Kit Checklist

1. Water - One gallon per person, per day for three days:

- ☑ Two quarts for drinking
- ☑ Two quarts for food preparation

2. Food - Select foods that require no refrigeration, preparation or cooking and little or no water. Select food items that are compact and lightweight:

- ☑ Ready-to-eat canned meats, fruits, and vegetables
- ☑ Canned juices, milk, soup (if powdered store extra water)
- ☑ Staples: sugar, salt, pepper
- ☐ High-energy foods: peanut butter, jelly, crackers, granola bars, trail mix, vitamins
- ☑ Food for infants, elderly people, or special diets
- ☑ Comfort/Stress food: cookies, hard candy, sweetened cereals, lollipops, instant coffee, tea bags

3. First Aid Supplies:

- ☑ Sterile adhesives bandages in assorted sizes
- ☑ 2 and 4 inch sterile gauze pads
- ☑ Hypoallergenic adhesive tape
- ☑ Triangular bandages
- ☑ Sterile roller bandages
- ☑ Scissors, tweezers, needles
- ☑ Moistened Towelettes, antiseptic
- ☑ Thermometer, tongue blades safety pins
- ☑ Petroleum jelly, cleansing agents/soap
- ☑ Latex gloves
- ☑ Sunscreen
- Aspirin/pain reliever, anti-diarrhea medication, antacid, syrup of ipecac, laxatives

- ☑ Fire extinguisher
- ☑ Tube tent

- Matches in waterproof container
